§ 302-5 : The use of sound amplifiers outside buildings within the Village of Allouez is prohibited without a permit to do so from the Village. The Village shall not grant a permit to use a sound amplifier during nighttime hours (10:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.) or to operate such sound amplifier in the vicinity of health facilities, churches while services are being conducted, or schools which are in session. The Village may order a reduction in the volume of such sound amplification on complaint being made by a citizen or when such sound amplification is a nuisance because of the volume, the method in which it is being used, or the location in which it is being operated.

Overall the attendance was down Once again 2021. We estimate about 2400 people attended the event. Still a great turnout considering we were still in a pandemic

Oktoberfest 2022 is September 16 and 17. We would like to go again with the extended noise ordinance Friday, September 16, from 3:00 p.m. until 11:00 p.m. with the lot emptied by 11:00 p.m. Saturday, September 17, we would like to go from 2:00 p.m. until 11:00 p.m. with the lot emptied by 11:00 p.m. This is huge for the attendees. The bands would end at 10:00 p.m. On a side note, 2021 we were able to donate \$4900.00 back into the community. The CP Center, Altrusa House, Leonard Hack Memorial Scholarship and Allouez Beautification, Pearly Gates Veterans, all received some donations.

We will have security for checking identification and overall control. We like to think we run a well controlled event.

For 2022, we would like to have our liquor license extended to the outside parking lot from May 1, 2022 until October 31, 2022. This would include Oktoberfest. We would like to once again put up our temporary patio for patrons to enjoy the weather and have a drink. This has certainly helped with our customers who felt compromised during the pandemic. At present, we are still not back to prepandemic numbers.

Dear Allouez Village Board Members,

RE: 16th Annual Lorelei Oktoberfest Event

I contacted Lynne Stahl of the Lorelei Inn on 4/14/22 via a telephone call and reviewed their request for a Noise Variance permit application. The permit includes a request for live bands and tents set up for the dates of September 16-17th, 2018. The owners have an action plan that is very organized and well-thought out from the previous years of running this event and included the following items we reviewed:

1. There will be 2 tents located in the parking lots on the south side of the Lorelei Inn and Lynne stated they did not have any traffic issues with Allouez Terrace last year. Allouez Terrace will be closed but the tents are moveable if an emergency presents itself.
2. 8+bouncers will be utilized to stop the possibility of underage drinkers with one main entry point for the tent.
3. Lynne states their action plan for the customers is after the music ends at 10:00pm, the patrons would be directed inside the tavern and out of the parking lots no later than 11:00pm.
4. Lynne will be the contact person at the phone numbers provided if there are any problems concerning the Brown County Sheriff's Office.

A record check was performed on last year's Oktoberfest event. Only one parking complainant was made in the area. Due to the organizational plan and the low volume of parking complainants for a large event like this, I am recommending the village board approve this Noise Variance Permit Application.
