DISCUSSION RE: SUNSET CIRCLE HISTORIC DISTRICT NOMINATION & RECOGNITION

Staff shared the Sunset Circle District was listed on the National Register. However, one home that was included in the district on the State Register, did not make it on the National Register as a contributing property. The State has encouraged the village to individually list the Lombardi House for honorific purposes.

DISCUSSION RE: SUNRISE PARK NATIONAL REGISTER ELIGIBILITY

Staff shared the conversations with the State Historic Preservation Office and other local historians regarding the viability of the Sunrise ark neighborhood as an eligible district. Unfortunately, the overall continuity of the neighborhood from a geographic stand point and an architectural perspective likely make the neighborhood ineligible at this time. However, we should explore further when the village updates the Intensive Survey Report.
