Village of Allouez Boards, Committees & Commissions

Board of Appeals

Board is responsible for granting or denying special exceptions to the zoning code.

- Meets 2nd Monday of the month at 5:15 p.m. (if petitions are filed)

Board of Ethics

Board is responsible for reviewing any ethics complaints filed and reviewing the Village's Ethics Code.

- Meets annually/on as needed basis

Board of Review

Board meets annually to review the Assessment Roll as prepared by the Assessor and make any corrections as necessary. They also hold hearings for any property owner's objection to their assessment to determine if an adjustment is necessary or justified.

- Meets annually (May or June). Meets twice during a revaluation year.

Community Development Authority

Responsible for working with Plan Commission and Village Board on planning & implementing various community development programs.

- Meets the 1st Thursday of the month at 8:00am.

Parks, Recreation & Forestry Committee

Committee is responsible for making recommendations on the Parks, Recreation, and Forestry annual budget and other department issues.

- Meets 4th Tuesday of the month at 5:30 p.m.

Public Works Committee

Committee provides oversight of the Public Works annual budget and funding for capital projects, input to operations services and long-range planning, and such other matters as requested by the Village Board.

- Meets 1st Tuesday of the month at 5:30 p.m.

Historic Preservation Commission

Commission recommends the designation of historic sites, structures, and districts and reviews proposed projects that will alter, repair, rehabilitate, reconstruct, or raze any improvement upon such structure and may issue a certificate of appropriateness.

- Meets intermittently (if needed)

Plan Commission

Commission acts as an advisory committee to the Village Board and staff for the community planning and land use management in Allouez. The Plan Commission is responsible for review of site plans, recommend changes in zoning ordinances, and evaluation of zoning requests

- Meets 3rd Tuesday of the month at 5:30 p.m.
